1. Introduction

1.1 All AFISNET SNMC meetings had the cause to repeatedly enumerate the menace associated to ATS missing FPLs.

ANSPs are doing all they can to reduce to the barest minimum in percentage terms this phenomena.

In APIRG 21 and 22 meetings, the issue of missing FPLs was topical.

In all these discussions, the issue of non-existence of ATS Messages and missing FPLs detailing all the statistics, that about 80% of missing FPLs are associated to Africa.

It is important to put in place measures to mitigate the issue of missing flight plans since it can be a threat to safety in our air spaces.




























2.2 **Identified** Causes of missing flight plans in Accra Center

- Flights without FPL at KIA.
- FPL not recieved
- Circuit interruption
- AFTN Link failures between centers (specifically the obsolete IBS satellite network eg the MOL2P multiplexers)
- Wrong addressing of flight plans causing the AFTN system to reject the messages
- Wrong setting of address between systems (eg. AFTN to ATM systems
- Wrong AFTN protocol setting between centers
- Failure to update routing tables of the AFTN systems
- Time synchronization between the AFTN and ATM systems
- ANSP's internal procedures.
- Wrong use of circuit identification/channel IDs.
- Defective circuits.
- Human factors (individuals & systems).
- Lack of coordination at the various AFTN/AMHS centers

2.3 Mitigation measures

Establish a flight plan taskforce to examine the causes of the missing FPL on a timely and systematic basis.

Exchange on Monthly basis data on missing flight plan among states

Implementation of collective addressing has helped remedy the situation.

Improvement on system failures due to a better management platform by way of Whatsapp groups.
